2013 Klang Yiwu Friendship Cities International Commodities Expo



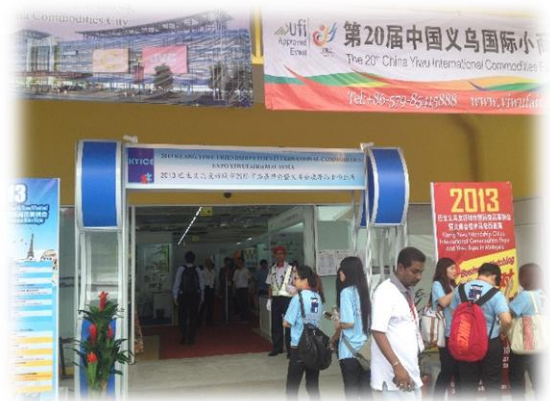
Looking to the Future: Trends, Challenges and Opportunities in GM Klang
